



## **Data Protection Notice**

of the  
**St. George Lodge of Royal Ark Master Mariners No. 383**  
(hereafter referred to below as “St.George RAM Lodge”)

### **Your data**

This notice is for all candidates and members of St.George RAM Lodge. It applies to the processing of your personal data by the Lodge.

**Section I** below sets out the purposes for which your data will be used by the Lodge while you are a **CANDIDATE** for the Lodge.

**Section II** below sets out the purposes for which your data will be used by the Lodge while you are a **MEMBER** of the Lodge.

*Please note that your personal data will also be processed by the GRAND LODGE OF ROYAL ARK MARINERS OF ENGLAND AND WALES AND IT'S DISTRICTS AND LODGES OVERSEAS, and also, the PROVINCIAL GRAND LODGE OF ROYAL ARK MARINERS OF DEVONSHIRE, as separate data controllers, and so you are also referred to their respective Data Protection Notices.*

### **I. Use of your data during your application to become a Royal Ark Mariner**

As a candidate to become a Royal Ark Mariner, you consent to the processing, retention, and sharing of your personal data for the purpose of assessing your membership application and any other Masonic applications you may make.

You can withdraw your consent and request erasure of your data at any time prior to your initiation by notifying your proposer and seconder that you wish to cancel your application.

### **II. Use of your data after you become a Royal Ark Mariner**

As a Royal Ark Mariner your data will be processed, retained, and shared for any reasonable purposes required by the regulations contained in the Mark Masons Combined Book of Constitutions, issued by the Grand Lodge of Mark Master Masons, or the bodies it sanctions from time to time. These purposes include, but are not limited to, the following purposes:

1. Assessing any Masonic applications you make;
  2. Registering you as a Royal Ark Mariner member;
  3. Receiving communications to which you are entitled as a Royal Ark Mariner;
  4. Recording the progress of your career the Royal Ark Mariner Order;
- and
5. Masonic disciplinary processes.

You may stop your data from being used by the Lodge by resigning from the Lodge.

The legal basis on which your personal data will be used in accordance with this Section II are:

1. The legitimate interests of the Lodge as a not for profit membership organisation;
- and
2. The fulfilment of contractual obligations owed to you by your Lodge.
